

1. The Sterrare è Umano Trophy is a national non-competitive and non-timed event. The route is divided into 3 sections, covering approximately 500 km. All participants are required to strictly adhere to the current traffic regulations.
2. The mileage provided by the Organization may vary due to unforeseen circumstances or forced deviations.
3. The event has a purely historical and cultural character, allowing participants to explore the places, history, culture, and traditions of the Abruzzo region.
4. The event will take place on roads open to public vehicular traffic and consists mainly of unpaved roads (off-road mode) or asphalted roads (on-road mode).
5. The departure and arrival are scheduled at Pala Dean Martin, Montesilvano Spiaggia (Pescara) which will be called VILLAGE. In the place of arrival and departure temporary non-compulsory and not guarded parking areas will be set up delimited by fences or recommended by the staff present on site.

The organization does not assume any responsibility of any kind for theft and damage in the aforementioned areas.

6. The event is confirmed in all weather conditions.
7. The organizer will send the participant by email the GPX files a few days before the date of the event.
8. Three tracks are foreseen, the N for beginners OFF ROAD, the H for experienced OFF ROAD drivers and the R for ON ROAD drivers
9. The participant must present himself at the start with the track already loaded on his GPS device. It will be not possible to download the tracks onsite.
10. Motorcycles suitable for the route are admitted, in compliance with the Highway Code and Traffic Regulations. Enduro specialistic motorbikes, quads or scooters are NOT authorized to participate to this event.
11. It is mandatory to participate with suitable clothing: motorcycle suit with protections, boots, gloves, helmet, etc. The penalty if no suitable clothing is exclusion from the event without any refund.
12. For the OFF ROAD mode it is mandatory to mount knobby tires to your motorcycle; without knobby tires the penalty is exclusion from the event without any refund.
13. All citizens of the world in possession of a valid driving license are admitted.
14. In case of justified and documented renunciation, the participant must promptly communicate it by e-mail to info@sterrareumano.it.

In case of cancellation, the following penalties will be applied from the date 25/04/2024:

- 14.1. up to 60 days: no penalty, full refund of the fee.
- 14.2. 59 to 30: 50% of the fee will be refunded.
- 14.3. 30 to 0: no refund
- 14.4. In the case of cancellation by the organizer, the entire amount paid will be refunded.
- 14.5. In the case of cancellation due to force majeure, for example due to Covid-19, the event will be moved later and the participant already registered can choose whether to remain registered for the new date or receive a refund of the amount paid.

15. Neither the Motoclub Lo Sherpa nor Sterrare è Umano are Tour Operators therefore overnight stays cannot be included in the registration fee.

16. Each participant with the sole fact of being registered TACITALLY AUTHORIZES the Motoclub LO SHERPA and ASD STERRARE È UMANO organizer of the event STERRARE È UMANO TROPHY with the UTILISATION of everyone's image. Motoclub LO SHERPA and ASD STERRARE È UMANO will be able to use and disclose these images both for production of videos/ DVDs and for creation of reportages and journalistic articles, for this purpose it will give mandate and AUTHORIZATION to professionals in the sector to carry out video/photographic services.

17. Registration Fees for Each Participant:

- €490.00 per participant for OFF-ROAD tracks for all days of the event if registration and payment are made by February 28, 2023.
- €550.00 per participant for OFF-ROAD tracks for all days of the event if registration and payment are made after February 28, 2023.
- €150.00 per participant for ONE DAY.

The fee includes: GPS track, route map, mechanical and medical assistance during the route, FMI event insurance, first-aid assistance, access to the Village, identification pass, event wristband, access to evening dinners at the end of each stage, souvenir gadgets.

The fee does not include: mandatory FMI membership, overnight stays, gasoline, vehicle recovery using rescue vehicles other than those of the organization.

18. Participants can purchase additional 'meals' for each accompanying person. The cost of each additional 'meal' is €40.00 for adults and €15.00 for children (ages 3 to 14).

19. Additional meals can be purchased until Thursday, April 25, 2024, at the Montesilvano Village (PESCARA).

20. In the event of withdrawal during the event, participants are required to immediately notify via WhatsApp to the emergency number provided through a sticker, which must be applied to the motorcycle.

The fee does not include: mandatory FMI membership, overnight stays, petrol, vehicle recovery with means of rescue other than those of the organization.

18. The participant may purchase additional 'meals' for each person defined as an accompanying person. The cost of each additional 'meal' is € 30.00 per adult, € 15.00 per children (ages 3 to 14)

19. Additional meals can be purchased no later than Thursday 28/04/2022 at the Village in Montesilvano (Pescara).

20. The participant, in case of withdrawal during the event, is required to communicate it immediately via Whatsapp at the emergency number. A sticker with the emergency number will be given to all participants. It is mandatory to stick it on the motorbike.

21. The means of assistance which are following the event will only provide technical and mechanical assistance which can be solved without major equipment and work commitments. For more complex jobs the participant will have to provide his equipment and spare parts. In case of immobilization of the vehicle our assistance will provide, where possible, to bring the immobilized vehicle to the first asphalted road available so as to allow a tow truck intervention for the withdrawal of the same (FMI agreement for tow trucks).

22. The maximum number of participants is set up to 150. Any exceeding of this limit remains an unquestionable decision of the Organizer.

23. The Organizer reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to refuse registration to a participant who is deemed not suitable for participation in the event.

24. The organization reserves the right to inform, by email and communications, any changes that will be considered appropriate to be added to this regulation, these will have to be considered an integral part.
